

Moena policies regarding alcohol service

At Moena we recognize the role that alcoholic beverages play in our guests' dining experience. We are committed to providing an enjoyable experience in a responsible and friendly manner. In addition to liquor laws that we are obligated to follow, we have developed the following policies in order to ensure a positive experience for all of our guests:

- Any Manager or Server has the authority to check ID to verify proof of age. No one under the age of 21 is permitted to purchase or consume alcoholic beverages.
- Valid proof of age is required for any guest who appears to be under age 30. The only acceptable forms of ID are:
 - A valid driver license issued by any state
 - A valid photo identification card issued by any state
 - A valid US armed forces ID card (must contain the holder's photo)
 - A valid passport which contains the holder's photo
- Failure or refusal to provide valid ID will result in refusal to serve alcohol.
- Moena will deny alcohol service to anyone who is visibly intoxicated, as determined by any Manager or Server.
- Guests who are found to be using foul language or harassing other guests (in the opinion of any Manager or Server) will be asked to pay their bill and leave the restaurant.
- Last pour of alcoholic beverages is 30 minutes after the kitchen closes, or at the discretion of the Manager on duty.
- Moena does not serve shots of liquor. Any Manager or Server has the right to determine if drinks ordered without mixers ("neat", "straight", "up", etc.) are, in fact, being consumed as shots.
- Guests who purchase a bottle of wine as part of their meal may recork and take the unfinished portion of wine when they leave.
- Outside alcoholic beverages are not permitted to be brought into Moena. However, a guest may bring a special bottle of wine to the restaurant, for which a \$25 corkage fee will be charged.
- Minors are permitted in the bar area of Moena, provided they are accompanied at all times during their visit by a parent or guardian.
